Fick started his career in coal at the Fuel Research Institute of South Africa (FRI) during the early 1960's.

Fick saw the transition of the FRI to the NICR (National Institute for Coal Research) and later to the Division of Energy Technology at the CSIR where he was Program Manager of the Coal Preparation programme.

He co-authored the original "Coal Preparation for Plant Operators" handbook and assisted with the translation into Afrikaans.

Fick officially retired from the CSIR in 1990 but never retired from the coal industry. He leaves his wife Rosa and three daughters. Our condolences got out to his wife and daughters.


